Over the past 28 years, SRT has contributed to the continuing education of many outstanding students in our local communities. SRT supports those special students who exemplify their potential to become the leaders of tomorrow.

In 2017, SRT will award four \$1000 scholarships to high school seniors who recognize the importance of volunteerism, community involvement, and academic achievement.

Eligibility

- Customers receiving any service from SRT and their dependents may apply for the scholarship.
- Graduating high school seniors are eligible to apply.
- Applicant must enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study no later than the fall term of the 2017-2018 school year at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school in the U.S.
- Applicant must have a grade point average of 2.0 or higher (C average).

Immediate family members of SRT directors and employees are not eligible.

How to Apply

1. Complete the application form in full.

2. Prepare a 300 word essay on the following topic: As a cooperative, SRT relies on local customers to keep our business viable. Many small businesses also rely on local shoppers to keep their doors open. However, in today's world, it is easy to simply push a button and order something online. If you were a local, small business owner, what would you do to attract customers and how would you stay competitive with the online shopping

world? And, how would you use Internet and technology to achieve your business goals and set yourself apart from the competition of online sites or big retail stores?

3. Include your high school transcript.
4. No references accepted.
5. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Award Procedure

- Four \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to first year (freshmen) college students.
- Scholarships will be based on community involvement, school activities, essay response, grade point average, and overall appearance of the application.
- Scholarship winners will be notified by mail in May 2017.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.
- The scholarship funds will be issued in August 2017 and will be sent directly to the Financial Aid Office at the institution you plan to attend.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, color, national origin, religion, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, or disability.
