Overview

Lutz Inclusive Childcare is an in-home daycare owned by Zach and Asher Lutz. Their goal is to provide an all inclusive learning facility to accommodate each child's individual needs. The goal of the Classroom Expansion project is to turn the partially finished basement into a positive, engaging, learning space for early childhood education.

Goals

1. Create an environment that promotes a love for learning
2. Create an environment where hands-on learning is accessible to each individual.

Specifications

Basement Renovation

The first thing that must be done to meet licensing standards is to put in an egress window. This is the biggest financial need along with the need to put up two walls that split the basement from the laundry and utility room.

Cost Estimation Breakdown

All estimations include installation and material cost

- Egress Window - 5,000 dollars
- Walls to separate utility and laundry room from classroom - 1,000 dollars
- 3,000 dollars will go towards new classroom Materials

Materials



600 dollars for new classroom seating. To create a space that is child centered and promotes independence.



1,000 dollars will go to new literacy materials including new books, alphabet recognition materials, and writing materials.

New language materials will help ensure children build a positive relationship with reading and help prepare for kindergarten.



1,200 dollars will go to creating a half bathroom in the classroom to help children learn bathroom skills and have the bathroom accessible 100 percent of the time.
