GIRL PROGRAMMING



In a classroom-style setting, girls prepare for the Cookie Program by earning financial literacy concepts like business management, goal setting, people skills, and decision making. Cookie University is teeing up each girl to become the best entrepreneur she can be. This program takes place in Sioux Falls, Rapid City, Fargo, Grand Forks, Minot and Bismarck in January and February.



The Believe in Girls (BIG) Event provides science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) concepts and educational exhibits to connect Girl Scouts and the community with opportunities not provided in a standard classroom setting. Local businesses are invited to host a booth and provide hands-on activities that introduce participants (ages K-12) to STEM. The BIG Event is hosted in Minot, Bismarck, Fargo, Grand Forks, Sioux Falls and Rapid City in September and October.



The Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards are the highest achievements a Girl Scout can earn and it's our honor to lift up their hard work during our recognition event - Honoring Excellence. We celebrate all that girls have accomplished while taking action to solve a problem in their communities. We invite the community to honor them with us in Fargo this June.



Girl Scout Camps

With Girl Scout campgrounds across North and South Dakota and council-powered outdoor programs, there are plenty of options for Girl Scouts to choose their own adventure in nature. Whether a Girl Scout is spending the week at Resident Camp at TDAF Camp in Aberdeen or attending a Day Camp at Camp Ocankusa in Mandan, girls are building confidence and becoming problem solvers.



Community members are invited to kick off summer by learning something new that takes their adventures outdoors. Hosted in Fargo and Sioux Falls, girls and families get to challenge themselves, explore interactive activities and experience the great outdoors.
