

# Short Term Care & Assessment Center



The Short Term Care & Assessment Center provides short-term placement for families facing issues such as parent/child conflict, runaway behaviors and anger management issues.

Parents maintain custody and reunification is typically scheduled within 96 hours or sooner.

## Eligibility

- Ages 10-17
- Parental consent is required and participation is necessary to develop an appropriate plan

## Support Services

- Assessment
- Individual & family counseling
- Safe housing with 24 hr staff supervision
- Mediation & family reunification counseling
- Mentoring & after care services
- Crisis services available 24/7
- Referral to programs within the community, as needed

## Attendant Care

Attendant care is a program to provide shelter and supervision to youth involved with law enforcement who cannot immediately be returned home. Release plans are dictated by law enforcement and the Juvenile Court system on a case-by-case basis. Placements are typically less than 48hrs.

## Supportive Services

- Assessment
- Safe housing with 24hr staff supervision
- Referral to short-term care for further assessment or longer placement

## Runaway

The Runaway Program provides emergency services to runaway youth and their families including crisis response, shelter, food and supplies.
